Parking Information for Contractors

1. **Contractor Parking Permits** can be obtained by licensed contractors to be used in the Downtown Core of Glenwood Springs.
2. The **Contractor Parking Permits** allow the contractor's vehicle to be parked up to 24 hours consecutively in the time-limited public parking zones and be exempt from fines.
3. **Contractor Parking Permits** for construction vehicles will be issued in person or via mail by the Police Department only AFTER the contractor has gone through the building permit and/or street obstruction permit process. Applicants must possess a City of Glenwood Springs Contractor's License.
4. A copy of the building and/or street obstruction permit and contractor's license must be presented to the Police Department to receive the **Contractor Parking Permit**.
5. Applicants will need to prove the vehicle essential. The type of business normally requires the vehicle to be on-site due to either A) The bulk of the items being used in the professional service, or B) The need for repeated and frequent trips for parts to and from the vehicle, and beyond that which could be easily unloadable.
6. There is no fee for the **Contractor Parking Permits**. Each applicant will be limited to two (2) permits per trade per building or street obstruction permit. The Contractor Parking Permit will be valid for one month for each vehicle a permit is issued.
7. Display the **Contractor Parking Permit** in the lower left corner of the vehicle's windshield. The permit MUST be visible from outside the vehicle.
